

The Faculty of Medicine to be re-certified as “Miljøfyrtårn”

In April 2016, the Faculty of Medicine was certified as a “Miljøfyrtårn” (“Environmental Beacon”). The certification includes the departments, centers and the faculty administration. The certification was part of the fact that the University of Bergen, as the first of the major university in Norway, now became a “Miljøfyrtårn”.

Being a “Miljøfyrtårn” involves systematic work on environmental measures in everyday life. The organization must meet requirements and implement measures for a more environmentally friendly operation and a healthy working environment.

To be certified as a “Miljøfyrtårn”, means that the faculty must meet a number of requirements within systematic HSE work, as well as requirements for waste, procurement, transport and energy. All these requirements must be documented.

We must also meet all the requirements necessary for a good HSE system.

Being a “Miljøfyrtårn” commits us as an institution and as an individual employee to make environmentally conscious choices in everyday life.
