Referring to *Publikasjoner i doktorgradsavhandlinger (Publications in doctoral theses)*:

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When submitting a doctoral thesis, a statement of co-authorship from the department the candidate is affiliated with must be enclosed. When a work has several authors, this indicates that the work is performed by a research group. Both main supervisor and head of department must, in collaboration, give the statement and also sign it. The statement shall describe the doctorate's working process and contributions to the individual parts of the work, and must also explain the collaboration with other institutions. In addition, the statement must mention relevant elements such as for instance extensive collaboration with other institutions that has involved an unusually high number of co-authors. The Faculty of Medicine follows the Vancouver rules. The statement of Co-authorship must be given in the same language as the dissertation.

Description of the doctorate's working process and contribution to the individual parts of the doctoral dissertation

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This statement of co-authorship must be submitted as an attachment to the «*Application for submission of doctoral thesis and suggested expert committee*».
